Epic Pass Raises Prices, Adds Crans-Montana for 2024-25. Vail Resorts' Epic Pass suite for 2024-25 has the unrestricted Epic Pass launching at \$982 and the Epic Local pass retailing for \$731, new highs for the products and about an 8 percent increase from last year, when they were \$909 and \$676, respectively. Ikon Pass Increases Prices, Adds Benefits for 2024-25. The 2024-25 Ikon Pass suite goes on sale March 14, with 58 destinations and a handful of new benefits. The company has bumped up prices, with the unrestricted Ikon Pass retailing for \$1,249 (compared to \$1,159 last year) and the Ikon Base Pass on sale for \$869 (up from \$829 last year). More. SAM
