

Florida Ski Council Golf Scramble, Mission Inn, June 04, 2022

Hi Golfer's, Beginning Golfers and Want to be Golfers!

Let's Have FUN with a Meet & Greet Ski Club Members & Ski Area Reps.

Welcome to the FSC Annual Golf Scramble and Golf Outing at Mission Inn. This year's format has changed. The change will be 9-hole scramble to begin the golf outing. In the past, we have played an 18-hole scramble with a 1 pm shotgun start. The problem was, too many teams were still on the golf course at 5 & 6 o'clock.

This did not allow Industry Partners (and Club Members) time to return to Mission Inn, shower, dress and go to the Conference Center to set up their displays. This year, only the first 9-holes will be the tournament scramble (rules to follow). Golfers, if they like, will be allowed to continue golfing and play the full 18 holes. Golfers will be able to leave the golf group and return to the Inn as their schedule dictates.

All teams will tee off on the El Campeon course with straight tee times (no shotgun start) beginning at 1:08 pm. Teams and tee times will be assigned and available Saturday and posted outside of the FSC meeting room. The cost of the golf outing is \$58 + tax, which includes shared golf cart and range balls. The El Campeon golf course snakes through the development and passes by Mission Inn, where the pool and volleyball are located. If a team member needs to leave the group, this would be a good time.

Here are the rules of the 4-person scramble. All golfers tee off (Men from the White tees, Women from the Red tees) and the best shot is selected from the tee shots. After the best shot is selected, all other golfers will pick up their golf ball and move it within one (1) club length of that ball. The ball cannot improve the lie. In other words, if you are in the rough or sand trap, your team must play from that terrain. The balls can be placed no closer to the green (only sideways or backward). This will continue through the first 9-holes. On the Green, the selected ball, and subsequent placement of the other balls, may not be placed more than 3 inches from the original shot.

All tournament instructions will be placed on each golf cart and announced prior to the tee times.

Other Information:

- Sign Up Cut Off – May 27, 2022 at 5 pm
- Ability: Advance (0-15 Handicap), Adv-Int (16-25 Handicap), Intermediate (25-35 Handicap), Beginner (36+ Handicap), and Never Ever Golfer (but want to have fun).
- Teams will be selected by average handicap per foursome. Mix of Reps & Club Members.
- Tee Times and Pairings will be emailed and posted Saturday Morning outside the FSC meeting room.
- For Club rentals call the Pro Shop at 352-324-3101.
- Pay for golf round at Pro Shop following FSC luncheon.
